

# Autumn One in Year 1

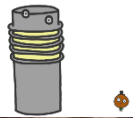


## English

This half term we will start off by reading some of the stories from the collection 'The inventions of Noodle and Titch'. We will be focusing on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our sentences. We will be working on skills we can use to help us write a sentence independently, such as counting the words in the sentence aloud first before writing them.

### Phonics

In Phonics this half term, we will be assessing all of the children ready to start our new phonics scheme. We will consolidate the learning from Reception and then will be moving on to learning new diagraphs. We will share each week which new sounds have been taught.

## Maths

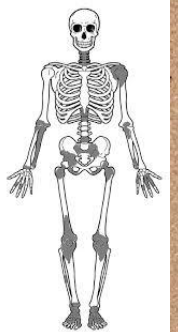
In Maths, we will be focusing on place value and Addition and Subtraction. Children will be given a range of opportunities to explore these concepts with practical resources, and they will be developing their skills in recording their written answers.

## Information

**Seesaw** – You will have received a log on for Seesaw. We will be using seesaw throughout the year in a range of different subjects. Children will be able to upload their work to Seesaw so that they can share what they have been getting up to with you. We will also be sending a weekly message to update you with that week's learning.

## Science

Animals, including humans is our unit for this half term in science. This unit takes children through lessons where they learn how to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.



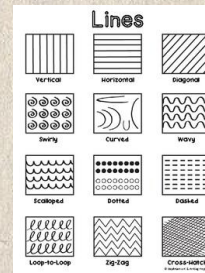
## History

This half term we will be answering the question 'How am I making History?'. The children will be looking at timelines and how to create a timeline of their own lives so far. We will also be looking at how we remember events that have happened for example. Birthdays. We will then go on to look at how childhoods are different now to when are parents and grandparents grew up.



## Art

In Art, we will be focussing on drawing. We will be helping pupils to understand and use different line types and mark-making techniques in drawing, enhancing their ability to describe lines, control drawing materials like pencils and chalk, and experiment with various media, while responding to music.



## Music

In Music, children will be exploring keeping the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring their favourite things.

## PSHE

Children will be thinking about others feelings and what can do as individuals to make people feel welcome. We will also be thinking about how we make good choices.

## Computing

In computing, children will be developing their understanding of technology and how it can help them in their everyday lives. They will start to become familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills. We will discuss how to use technology responsibly.



## PE

Our focus for this half term in PE will be 'Attack, Defend, Shoot'. It will give children the opportunity to practise basic movements, including running, jumping, etc. and begin to engage in competitive activities. Experience opportunities to improve their agility, balance, coordination and speed.
